As of today, a cumulative total of **644 438** confirmed COVID-19 cases in South Africa have been recorded with 2 007 new cases identified.

### **Total Deaths and Recoveries**

Regrettably, we report **97** more COVID-19 related deaths: 17 from KwaZulu-Natal, 21 from Gauteng, 7 from Eastern Cape, 4 from Free State, 1 from Limpopo, 26 from Mpumalanga, 15 from North West, 6 from Western Cape. This brings the total number of COVID-19 related deaths to **15 265**.

We extend our condolences to the loved ones of the departed and thank the health care workers that treated the deceased patients.

Our recoveries now stand at **573 003** which translates to a recovery rate of 88,9%
