





GUIDELINES OF ABSTRACT: 13TH WORLD ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DAY (WEHD) COMMEMORATION

The theme for WEHD 2024 is "Environmental health: Creating resilient communities through disaster risk reduction and climate change mitigation and adaptation".

Scientific abstracts should include the background, objectives, methodology, results, conclusion and recommendations.

Operational research abstracts (i.e. case study/good practice write-up) should include the background, intervention, results, lessons learnt and recommendations.

Presentation:

- Oral presentation: 15 minutes presentation on Microsoft PowerPoint with five minutes for discussions.
- Poster presentation: 5 minutes presentation on the poster with three minutes discussion.

Final version of presentation:

- Final presentation to be delivered during the conference should be submitted to the organisers 14 days before the presentation date.
- The abstract should be a one pager of not more than 300 words.

The abstract should adhere to the following:

- Have an introduction, body and conclusion.
- Be written in English.
- Be relevant to the theme and thematic area.
- The work was done in the period between 2019 and 2024.
- The work is owned by an individual or group.
- The document is in Microsoft Word, single-spaced, using Arial size 12 font.
- The presenter must indicate whether it will be an oral or poster presentation.

Notes:

- Feedback will be given to all applicants on the status of the abstract.
- Presenters to plan for their travel and accommodation to the venue.
